6	(1) in paragraph (11), by striking "or" at the

8	(2) in paragraph (12) , by striking the period at
9	the end and inserting "; or"; and
10	(3) by adding at the end the following para-
11	graph:
12	"(13) if in a package or other container at the
13	final point of sale it contains low-temperature ren-
14	dered product, also known as lean finely textured
15	beef (as such terms are defined by the Secretary),
16	unless it bears a label stating that it contains such
17	product.".
