A BILL

To suspend temporarily the duty on cyan 854 inkjet printing ink.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,

SECTION 1. CYAN 854 INKJET PRINTING INK.

(a) IN GENERAL.—Heading 9902.40.41 of the Harmonized Tariff Schedule of the United States (relating to
Cyan 854 inkjet printing ink) is amended by—

(1) striking "0.3%" and inserting "Free"; and
(2) striking "12/31/2012" and inserting "12/
31/2015".

(b) Effective Date.—The amendments made by

subsection (a) apply with respect to goods entered, or

- 1 withdrawn from warehouse for consumption, on or after
- 2 the 15th day after the date of enactment of this Act.
