## A BILL

For the relief of Rosa Isela Figueroa Rincon, Miguel Angel Figueroa Rincon, Blanca Azucena Figueroa Rincon, and Nancy Araceli Figueroa Rincon.

1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the United States of America in Congress assembled, 2 3 SECTION 1. PERMANENT RESIDENT STATUS FOR ROSA 4 ISELA FIGUEROA RINCON, MIGUEL ANGEL 5 **FIGUEROA RINCON**, **BLANCA AZUCENA** 6 FIGUEROA RINCON, AND NANCY ARACELI 7 FIGUEROA RINCON.

8 (a) IN GENERAL.—Notwithstanding subsections (a)
9 and (b) of section 201 of the Immigration and Nationality
10 Act, Rosa Isela Figueroa Rincon, Miguel Angel Figueroa

Rincon, Blanca Azucena Figueroa Rincon, and Nancy
 Araceli Figueroa Rincon shall each be eligible for issuance
 of an immigrant visa or for adjustment of status to that
 of an alien lawfully admitted for permanent residence
 upon filing an application for issuance of an immigrant
 visa under section 204 of such Act or for adjustment of
 status to lawful permanent resident.

8 (b) Adjustment OF STATUS.—If Rosa Isela 9 Figueroa Rincon, Miguel Angel Figueroa Rincon, Blanca 10 Azucena Figueroa Rincon, or Nancy Araceli Figueroa Rincon enters the United States before the filing deadline 11 12 specified in subsection (c), he or she shall be considered 13 to have entered and remained lawfully and shall, if otherwise eligible, be eligible for adjustment of status under 14 15 section 245 of the Immigration and Nationality Act as of the date of the enactment of this Act. 16

17 (c) WAIVER OF GROUNDS FOR REMOVAL OR DENIAL18 OF ADMISSION.—

19 GENERAL.—Notwithstanding sections (1)IN 20 212(a) and 237(a) of the Immigration and Nation-21 ality Act, Rosa Isela Figueroa Rincon, Miguel Angel 22 Figueroa Rincon, Blanca Azucena Figueroa Rincon, 23 and Nancy Araceli Figueroa Rincon may not be re-24 moved from the United States, denied admission to 25 the United States, or considered ineligible for lawful permanent residence in the United States, by reason
 of any ground for removal or denial of admission
 that is reflected in the records of the Department of
 Homeland Security or the Visa Office of the Depart ment of State, on the date of the enactment of this
 Act.

7 (2) Rescission of outstanding order of 8 **REMOVAL.**—The Secretary of Homeland Security 9 shall rescind any outstanding order of removal or de-10 portation, or any finding of inadmissibility or de-11 portability, that has been entered against Rosa Isela 12 Figueroa Rincon, Miguel Angel Figueroa Rincon, 13 Blanca Azucena Figueroa Rincon, or Nancy Araceli 14 Figueroa Rincon by reason of any ground described 15 in paragraph (1).

(d) DEADLINE FOR APPLICATION AND PAYMENT OF
FEES.—Subsections (a) and (b) shall apply only if the application for issuance of an immigrant visa or the application for adjustment of status is filed with appropriate fees
within 2 years after the date of the enactment of this Act.

(e) REDUCTION OF IMMIGRANT VISA NUMBER.—
Upon the granting of an immigrant visa or permanent residence to Rosa Isela Figueroa Rincon, Miguel Angel
Figueroa Rincon, Blanca Azucena Figueroa Rincon, and
Nancy Araceli Figueroa Rincon, the Secretary of State

shall instruct the proper officer to reduce by 4, during the 1 2 current or next following fiscal year, the total number of immigrant visas that are made available to natives of the 3 4 country of the aliens' birth under section 203(a) of the 5 Immigration and Nationality Act or, if applicable, the 6 total number of immigrant visas that are made available 7 to natives of the country of the aliens' birth under section 202(e) of such Act. 8

9 (f) DENIAL OF PREFERENTIAL IMMIGRATION TREAT-10 MENT FOR CERTAIN RELATIVES.—The natural parents, 11 brothers, and sisters of Rosa Isela Figueroa Rincon, 12 Miguel Angel Figueroa Rincon, Blanca Azucena Figueroa 13 Rincon, and Nancy Araceli Figueroa Rincon shall not, by 14 virtue of such relationship, be accorded any right, privi-15 lege, or status under the Immigration and Nationality Act.
