To extend and modify the temporary suspension of duty on certain women's footwear.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. CERTAIN WOMEN'S FOOTWEAR.
- 4 (a) In General.—Heading 9902.23.83 of the Har-
- 5 monized Tariff Schedule of the United States (relating to
- 6 certain women's footwear with outer soles of rubber, plas-
- 7 tics, leather, or composition leather and uppers of textile
- 8 materials) is amended—
- 9 (1) in the article description column, by striking
- "\$20/pair" and inserting "\$24/pair"; and

- 1 (2) by striking the date in the effective period 2 column and inserting "12/31/2015".
- 3 (b) Effective Date.—The amendments made by
- 4 subsection (a) apply to goods entered, or withdrawn from
- 5 warehouse for consumption, on or after the 15th day after
- 6 the date of the enactment of this Act.
