A BILL

To suspend temporarily the duty on artificial staple fibers
of viscose rayon, not carded, combed or otherwise pro-
cessed for spinning.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. ARTIFICIAL STAPLE FIBERS OF VISCOSE**
4 **RAYON, NOT CARDED, COMBED OR OTHER-**
5 **WISE PROCESSED FOR SPINNING.**

6 (a) IN GENERAL.—Subchapter II of chapter 99 of
7 the Harmonized Tariff Schedule of the United States is
8 amended by inserting in numerical sequence the following
9 new heading:

“	9902.01.00	Artificial staple fibers of viscose rayon, not carded, combed or otherwise processed for spinning, measuring greater than 1 decitex to 1.3 decitex and having a fiber length each measuring 20 mm or more but not over 150 mm (provided for in subheading 5504.10.00)	Free	No change	No change	On or before 12/31/2015	”.
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1 (b) **EFFECTIVE DATE.**—The amendment made by
 2 subsection (a) applies to goods entered, or withdrawn from
 3 warehouse for consumption, on or after the 15th day after
 4 the date of the enactment of this Act.
