## A BILL

To suspend temporarily the duty on certain window shade  
material.

1       *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2       *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3       **SECTION 1. CERTAIN WINDOW SHADE MATERIAL.**

4       (a) IN GENERAL.—Subchapter II of chapter 99 of  
5       the Harmonized Tariff Schedule of the United States is  
6       amended by inserting in numerical sequence the following  
7       new heading:

“	9902.01.00	Plaiting material products suitable for use in window shades, in rolls each having an area measuring over 27.85 m <sup>2</sup> but less than 46.46 m <sup>2</sup> , of wood slats each measuring over 6 mm or more but not greater than 8 mm in width or over 22 mm or more but not to exceed 25 mm in width and measuring 1 mm or more but not greater than 2 mm in thickness, and/or bamboo reeds measuring 1 mm or more but not greater than 2.5 mm in width, and/or marupa wood rods measuring over 1.5 mm or more but not greater than 3 mm in diameter, and/or paper rope, the foregoing woven with polyester yarn into a repeating pattern which may also include jute, polyester yarn or paper (provided for in subheading 4601.94.20)	Free	No change	No change	On or before 12/31/2015	”.

1           (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendment made by  
 2 subsection (a) applies to goods entered, or withdrawn from  
 3 warehouse for consumption, on or after the 15th day after  
 4 the date of the enactment of this Act.
