1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-

2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,

3 SECTION 1. CERTAIN SINGLE SERVE COFFEE MAKERS.

4 (a) IN GENERAL.—Subchapter II of chapter 99 of
5 the Harmonized Tariff Schedule of the United States is
6 amended by inserting in numerical sequence the following
7 new heading:

"	9902.01.00	Single serve "automatic drip" coffee makers with combination reusable ground coffee filter and holding area for pre-pack- aged coffee (provided for in subheading 8516.71.00)	Free	No change	No change	On or before	
						12/31/2015	".

(b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendment made by
 subsection (a) applies to articles entered, or withdrawn
 from warehouse for consumption, on or after the 15th day
 after the date of the enactment of this Act.
