- 3 SECTION 1. PHOSPHINIC ACID, DIETHYL-, ALUMINUM SALT
- 4 WITH SYNERGISTS AND ENCAPSULATING
- 5 AGENTS.
- 6 (a) In General.—Heading 9902.22.43 of the Har-
- 7 monized Tariff Schedule of the United States (relating to
- 8 Phosphinic acid, diethyl-, aluminum salt with synergists
- 9 and encapsulating agents) is amended by striking the date
- 10 in the effective period column and inserting "12/31/2015".

- 1 (b) Effective Date.—The amendment made by
- 2 subsection (a) applies with respect to goods entered, or
- 3 withdrawn from warehouse for consumption, on or after

4 the 15th day after the date of enactment of this Act.
