A BILL

To extend the temporary suspension of duty on Ethene, tetrafluoro, oxidized, polymerized reduced, methyl esters, reduced.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. ETHENE, TETRAFLUORO, OXIDIZED, POLYM-**
4 **ERIZED REDUCED, METHYL ESTERS, RE-**
5 **DUCED.**

6 (a) IN GENERAL.—Heading 9902.23.19 of the Har-
7 monized Tariff Schedule of the United States (relating to
8 Ethene, tetrafluoro, oxidized, polymerized reduced, methyl
9 esters, reduced) is amended by striking the date in the
10 effective period column and inserting “12/31/2015”.

1 (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendment made by
2 subsection (a) applies with respect to goods entered, or
3 withdrawn from warehouse for consumption, on or after
4 the 15th day after the date of enactment of this Act.
