## A BILL

To extend the temporary suspension of duty on Vinylidene chloride-methyl methacrylate-acrylonitrile copolymer.

1       *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2       *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3       **SECTION 1. VINYLIDENE CHLORIDE-METHYL METHACRY-**  
4       **LATE-ACRYLONITRILE COPOLYMER.**

5       (a) IN GENERAL.—Heading 9902.23.09 of the Har-  
6       monized Tariff Schedule of the United States (relating to  
7       Vinylidene chloride-methyl methacrylate-acrylonitrile co-  
8       polymer) is amended by striking the date in the effective  
9       period column and inserting “12/31/2015”.

1       (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendment made by  
2 subsection (a) applies with respect to goods entered, or  
3 withdrawn from warehouse for consumption, on or after  
4 the 15th day after the date of enactment of this Act.
