- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. VINYLIDENE CHLORIDE-METHYL METHACRY-
- 4 LATE-ACRYLONITRILE COPOLYMER.
- 5 (a) In General.—Heading 9902.23.09 of the Har-
- 6 monized Tariff Schedule of the United States (relating to
- 7 Vinylidene chloride-methyl methacrylate-acrylonitrile co-
- 8 polymer) is amended by striking the date in the effective
- 9 period column and inserting "12/31/2015".

- 1 (b) Effective Date.—The amendment made by
- 2 subsection (a) applies with respect to goods entered, or
- 3 withdrawn from warehouse for consumption, on or after

4 the 15th day after the date of enactment of this Act.
