To suspend temporarily the duty on man-made shells used in the manufacture of sleeping bags.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. MAN-MADE SHELLS USED IN THE MANUFAC-**
4 **TURE OF SLEEPING BAGS.**

5 (a) IN GENERAL.—Subchapter II of chapter 99 of
6 the Harmonized Tariff Schedule of the United States is
7 amended by inserting in numerical sequence the following
8 new heading:

“	9902.63.07	Man-made shells used in the manufacture of sleeping bags (provided for in subheading 6307.90.98)	Free	No change	No change	On or before 12/31/2015	”.

1 (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendment made by
2 subsection (a) applies to articles entered, or withdrawn
3 from warehouse for consumption, on or after the 15th day
4 after the date of the enactment of this Act.
