A BILL

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,

SECTION 1. CERTAIN AC ELECTRIC MOTORS OF AN OUT
PUT EXCEEDING 37.5 W BUT NOT EXCEEDING

72 W DESIGNED TO BE OPERATED BY MEANS

OF AN INFRARED REMOTE CONTROL.
