1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-

2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,

**3** SECTION 1. LANTHANUM PHOSPHATE PHOSPHOR.

4 (a) IN GENERAL.—Heading 9902.22.75 of the Har5 monized Tariff Schedule of the United States (relating to
6 lanthanum phosphate phosphor) is amended—

7 (1) in the article description column—

8 (A) by striking ", activated by cerium and
9 terbium, inorganic used as luminophores" and
10 inserting "with a median particle size between

1	2.5 and 4.1 microns, containing cerium and ter-
2	bium, used as a luminophore''; and
3	(B) by striking "subheading 3206.50.00"
4	and inserting "subheading 2846.90.80"; and
5	(2) by striking the date in the effective period
6	column and inserting "12/31/2015".
7	(b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendments made by
8	subsection (a) apply to goods entered, or withdrawn from
9	warehouse for consumption, on or after the 15th day after
10	the date of the enactment of this Act.
