- 3 SECTION 1. PERMITS FOR DREDGED OR FILL MATERIAL.
- 4 (a) Repeal.—Section 404(c) of the Federal Water
- 5 Pollution Control Act (33 U.S.C. 1344(c)) is repealed.

- 1 (b) Effective Date.—Subsection (a) shall apply to
- 2 a specification of a disposal site made under section 404
- 3 of the Federal Water Pollution Control Act (33 U.S.C.

4 1344) after the date of enactment of this Act.
