A BILL

To extend and modify the temporary suspension of duty on mixtures or coprecipitates of lanthanum, cerium, and terbium phosphates.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. MIXTURES OR COPRECIPITATES OF LAN-**
4 **THANUM, CERIUM, AND TERBIUM**
5 **PHOSPHATES.**

6 (a) IN GENERAL.—Heading 9902.23.05 of the Har-
7 monized Tariff Schedule of the United States (relating to
8 Lanthanum phosphate) is amended—

9 (1) by amending the article description to read
10 as follows: “Mixtures or coprecipitates of lanthanum

1 phosphate, cerium-doped lanthanum phosphate, ce-
2 rium phosphate, and terbium phosphate (CAS Nos.
3 13778-59-1, 95823-34-0, 13454-71-2 and 13863-
4 48-4) (provided for in subheadings 2846.10.00 and
5 2846.90.80)”; and

6 (2) by striking the date in the effective period
7 column and inserting “12/31/2015”.

8 (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendments made by
9 subsection (a) apply to goods entered, or withdrawn from
10 warehouse for consumption, on or after the 15th day after
11 the date of the enactment of this Act.
