A BILL

To suspend temporarily the duty on certain mechanics' work
gloves.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. CERTAIN MECHANICS' WORK GLOVES.**

4 (a) IN GENERAL.—Subchapter II of chapter 99 of
5 the Harmonized Tariff Schedule of the United States is
6 amended—

7 (1) by striking heading 9902.14.04; and

8 (2) by inserting in numerical sequence the fol-
9 lowing new heading:

“ 9902.14.04	Mechanics' work gloves, valued over \$5.58 per pair but not over \$7.22 per pair (provided for in sub- heading 6216.00.58)	Free	No change	No change	On or before 12/31/2015 ”.

1 (b) AMENDMENT TO U.S. NOTE.—Subchapter II of
2 chapter 99 is amended by striking existing U.S. Note 18
3 to such subchapter and by inserting in such subchapter
4 the following new U.S. Note:

5 “18. For purposes of heading 9902.14.04, the term
6 ‘mechanics’ work gloves’ means gloves having the fol-
7 lowing characteristics: imitation leather palms and fingers
8 with fourchettes; backs comprising either one layer of syn-
9 thetic knitted fabric or three layers with the outer layer
10 of synthetic knitted fabric, the center layer of foam and
11 the inner layer of tricot fabric.”.

12 (c) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendments made by
13 this section apply to goods entered, or withdrawn from
14 warehouse for consumption, on or after the 15th day after
15 the date of the enactment of this Act.
