7	(a) In General.—Subchapter II of chapter 99 of

	" 9902.01.00 Check valves of steel, having an opening approximately 7.62 cm. or more in diameter and certified by the importer as meeting ASME B16.34 certification requirements as approved for use in nuclear facilities (provided for in subheading 8481.30.20)

11 (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendment made by 12 subsection (a) applies with respect to goods entered, or 13 withdrawn from warehouse for consumption, on or after 14 the 15th day after the date of the enactment of this Act.

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
