## A BILL

To extend the temporary suspension of duty on Macroporous  
poly(divinylbenzene).

1       *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2       *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3       **SECTION 1. MACROPOROUS POLY(DIVINYLBENZENE).**

4       (a) IN GENERAL.—Heading 9902.22.11 of the Har-  
5       monized Tariff Schedule of the United States (relating to  
6       Macroporous poly(divinylbenzene)) is amended by striking  
7       “12/31/2012” and inserting “12/31/2015”.

8       (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendments made by  
9       subsection (a) apply with respect to goods entered, or

- 1 withdrawn from warehouse for consumption, on or after
- 2 the 15th day after the date of enactment of this Act.
