A BILL

To reduce temporarily the rate of duty on certain machinery
for molding unvulcanized rubber for tires.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. CERTAIN MACHINERY FOR MOLDING**
4 **UNVULCANIZED RUBBER FOR TIRES.**

5 (a) IN GENERAL.—Subchapter II of chapter 99 of
6 the Harmonized Tariff Schedule of the United States is
7 amended by inserting in numerical sequence the following
8 new heading:

“	9902.01.00	Numerically controlled machinery for molding or otherwise forming uncured, unvulcanized rubber to be used in production of radial tires, the foregoing not containing in a single housing both components for processing rubber, assembling tire components, and for curing green tires of subheading 4011.10.10 designed for use on motor cars (including stations wagons), such tires with rim diameters measuring 38.10 cm or more but not greater than 50.8 cm, and tires of subheading 4011.20.10 designed for use on on-highway light trucks, and parts thereof (provided for in subheading 8477.20.00)	Free	No change	No change	On or before 12/31/2015	”.
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1 (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendment made by
 2 subsection (a) applies to articles entered, or withdrawn
 3 from warehouse for consumption, on or after the 15th day
 4 after the date of the enactment of this Act.

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
