3       **SECTION     1.     2,5-DIMETHYL-2,     5     HEXANEDIOL**  
4               **(DIMETHYLHEXANEDIOL).**

5       (a) IN GENERAL.—Subchapter II of chapter 99 of  
6       the Harmonized Tariff Schedule of the United States is  
7       amended by inserting in numerical sequence the following  
8       new heading:
