SECTION 1. CERTAIN FOOTWEAR FOR GIRLS WITH OUTER

SOLES OF RUBBER, PLASTICS, LEATHER, OR

COMPOSITION LEATHER AND UPPERS OF

LEATHER, NOT COVERING THE ANKLE.
