To suspend temporarily the duty on certain non-women's
footwear.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. CERTAIN NON-WOMEN'S FOOTWEAR.**

4 (a) IN GENERAL.—Subchapter II of chapter 99 of
5 the Harmonized Tariff Schedule of the United States is
6 amended by inserting in numerical sequence the following
7 new heading:

“	9902.01.00	Other tennis shoes, basketball shoes, and the like, with outer soles of rubber, plastic, leather, or composition leather and uppers of leather, not covering the ankle, valued more than \$2.50/pair, other than house slippers and work footwear, the forgoing for persons other than women (provided for in sub-heading 6403.99.90)	Free	No change	No change	On or before 12/31/2015	”.
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1 (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendment made by
 2 subsection (a) applies to goods entered, or withdrawn from
 3 warehouse for consumption, on or after the 15th day after
 4 the date of the enactment of this Act.
