To suspend temporarily the duty on methylated and butylated melamine-formaldehyde polymer.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. METHYLATED AND BUTYLATED MELAMINE-**
4 **FORMALDEHYDE POLYMER.**

5 (a) IN GENERAL.—Subchapter II of chapter 99 of
6 the Harmonized Tariff Schedule of the United States is
7 amended by inserting in numerical sequence the following
8 new heading:

“	9902.01.00	Methylated and butylated melamine-formaldehyde polymer (CAS No. 68036-97-5) (provided for in subheading 3909.20.00)	Free	No change	No change	On or before 12/31/2015	”.

1 (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendment made by
2 subsection (a) applies with respect to goods entered, or
3 withdrawn from warehouse for consumption, on or after
4 the 15th day after the date of the enactment of this Act.
