- 6 (a) In General.—Heading 9902.70.19 of the Har-
- 7 monized Tariff Schedule of the United States (relating to
- 8 certain smooth nonwoven fiberglass sheets of a type pri-
- 9 marily used as acoustical facing for ceiling panels) is

- 1 amended by striking the date in the effective period col-
- 2 umn and inserting "12/31/2015".
- 3 (b) Effective Date.—The amendment made by
- 4 subsection (a) applies to goods entered, or withdrawn from
- 5 warehouse for consumption, on or after the 15th day after
- 6 the date of the enactment of this Act.
