3 **SECTION 1. CAST-IRON ENGINE CRANKCASES FOR MARINE**
4 **PROPULSION ENGINES, EACH MEASURING**
5 **MORE THAN 1.1 METERS IN LENGTH.**

6 (a) IN GENERAL.—Subchapter II of chapter 99 of
7 the Harmonized Tariff Schedule of the United States is
8 amended by inserting in numerical sequence the following
9 new heading:

“	9902.01.00	Cast-iron engine crank-cases for marine propulsion engines, each measuring more than 1.1 meters in length (provided for in subheading 8409.99.92)	Free	No change	No change	On or before 12/31/2015	”.

1 (b) **EFFECTIVE DATE.**—The amendment made by
 2 subsection (a) applies to goods entered, or withdrawn from
 3 warehouse for consumption, on or after the 15th day after
 4 the date of the enactment of this Act.
