- 3 SECTION 1. WOVEN FABRICS OF POLYESTER STAPLE FI-
- 4 BERS MIXED MAINLY WITH OR SOLELY WITH
- 5 MAN-MADE FILAMENTS.
- 6 (a) In General.—Subchapter II of chapter 99 of
- 7 the Harmonized Tariff Schedule of the United States is
- 8 amended by inserting in numerical sequence the following
- 9 new heading:

"	9902.01.00	Woven fabrics of polyester staple fibers mixed mainly with or solely with manmade filaments (provided for in subheading 5515.12.00)	Free	No change	No change	On or before	
						12/31/2015	".

- 1 (b) Effective Date.—The amendment made by
- 2 subsection (a) applies to articles entered, or withdrawn
- 3 from warehouse for consumption, on or after the 15th day
- 4 after the date of the enactment of this Act.
