7	(a) In General.—Subchapter II of chapter 99 of
8	the Harmonized Tariff Schedule of the United States is
9	amended by inserting in numerical sequence the following
10	new heading:
	" 9902.01.00 Woven fabrics of artificial staple fibers containing less than 85 percent by weight of artificial staple fibers, mixed mainly or solely with man-made filaments, of yarns of different colors (provided for in subheading 5516.23.00) Free No change On or before 12/31/2015 ".

11 (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendment made by 12 subsection (a) applies to articles entered, or withdrawn 13 from warehouse for consumption, on or after the 15th day

14 after the date of the enactment of this Act.
