### A BILL

#### **3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the "Army Corps of Engi-

5 neers Communications Accountability Act of 2012".

# 6 SEC. 2. NOTIFICATION AND CONSULTATION REQUIRE7 MENTS.

8 (a) IN GENERAL.—If the Chief of Engineers makes
9 an upper quartile determination or an upper decile deter10 mination, the Chief of Engineers shall notify the public

of such determination, and consult with affected govern ments, in accordance with this section.

3 (b) NOTIFICATION.—Not later than 7 days after
4 making a determination described in subsection (a), the
5 Chief of Engineers shall notify the public that such deter6 mination has been made.

7 (c) CONSULTATION.—

8 (1) IN GENERAL.—If the Chief of Engineers 9 makes an upper decile determination, an affected 10 government may request a consultation with the 11 Chief of Engineers.

(2) DEADLINE.—If an affected government requests a consultation under paragraph (1), the Chief
of Engineers shall provide such consultation not
later than 7 days after receiving the request.

16 (3) CONTENTS.—The Chief of Engineers may
17 provide in a consultation under this subsection—

18 (A) information regarding expected water19 levels;

20 (B) advice regarding appropriate prepared21 ness actions;

(C) technical assistance; and

23 (D) any other information or assistance
24 determined appropriate by the Chief of Engi25 neers.

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#### (d) DEFINITIONS.—In this section:

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(1) AFFECTED GOVERNMENT.—The term "affected government" means a State, local, or tribal
government with jurisdiction over an area that will
be affected by a flood occurring in the Missouri
River System, as determined by the Chief of Engineers in an upper decile determination.

8 (2) ANNUAL OPERATING PLAN.—The term "an-9 nual operating plan" means a plan prepared by the 10 Chief of Engineers that describes potential water 11 conditions scenarios for the Missouri River System 12 for a year.

(3) UPPER DECILE DETERMINATION.—The
term "upper decile determination" means a determination that runoff conditions in the Missouri
River System are likely to reach the upper decile
scenario specified for a year in an annual operating
plan.

(4) UPPER QUARTILE DETERMINATION.—The
term "upper quartile determination" means a determination that runoff conditions in the Missouri
River System are likely to reach the upper quartile
scenario specified for a year in an annual operating
plan.

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
