5 Notwithstanding any other provision of law, neither 6 the Secretary of the Interior nor the Secretary of Com-7 merce may issue any permit or in any other way authorize 8 any person to conduct commercial finfish aquaculture operations in the Exclusive Economic Zone of the United
States (as established by Proclamation Numbered 5030,
dated March 10, 1983), except in accordance with a law
authorizing such action that is enacted after the date of
the enactment of this Act.
