3 **SECTION 1. 1,2-BIS(3-AMINOPROPYL)ETHYLENEDIAMINE,**
4 **POLYMER WITH N-BUTYL-2,2,6,6-**
5 **TETRAMETHYL-4-PIPERIDINAMINE AND 2,4,6-**
6 **TRICHLORO-1,3,5-TRIAZINE.**

7 (a) IN GENERAL.—Heading 9902.22.60 of the Har-
8 monized Tariff Schedule of the United States (relating to

1 1,2-Bis(3-aminopropyl)ethylenediamine, polymer with N-
2 butyl-2,2,6,6-tetramethyl-4-piperidinamine and 2,4,6-
3 trichloro-1,3,5-triazine) is amended by striking “12/31/
4 2009” and inserting “12/31/2015”.

5 (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendments made by
6 subsection (a) apply with respect to goods entered, or
7 withdrawn from warehouse for consumption, on or after
8 the 15th day after the date of enactment of this Act.

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
