A BILL

To amend the Homeland Security Act of 2002 to require the Administrator of the Federal Emergency Management Agency to provide guidance to and coordination with local educational agencies and school districts that are at high risk of acts of terrorism or other incidents, and for other purposes.

1 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

2 This Act may be cited as the “Preparedness Coordi-
3 nation With Local Educational Agencies and School Dis-
4 tricts Act”.

5 **SEC. 2. GUIDANCE TO AND COORDINATION WITH LOCAL**
6 **EDUCATIONAL AGENCIES AND SCHOOL DIS-**
7 **TRICTS.**

8 (a) IN GENERAL.—Title V of the Homeland Security
9 Act of 2002 (6 U.S.C. 311 et seq.) is amended by adding
10 at the end the following new section:

11 **“SEC. 526. GUIDANCE TO AND COORDINATION WITH LOCAL**
12 **EDUCATIONAL AGENCIES AND SCHOOL DIS-**
13 **TRICTS.**

14 “To enhance domestic preparedness for and collective
15 response to terrorism and other incidents, the Adminis-
16 trator of the Federal Emergency Management Agency
17 shall provide guidance to and coordinate with local edu-
18 cational agencies and school districts that are at a high
19 risk of acts of terrorism or other incidents.”.

20 (b) CLERICAL AMENDMENT.—The table of contents
21 in section 1(b) of the Homeland Security Act of 2002 (6
22 U.S.C. 101(b)) is amended by adding after the item relat-
23 ing to section 525 the following new item:

“Sec. 526. Guidance to and coordination with local educational agencies and
school districts.”.

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
