## A BILL

To repeal the information reporting requirements added by the Patient Protection and Affordable Care Act.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. REPEAL OF EXPANSION OF INFORMATION RE-
- 4 PORTING REQUIREMENTS.
- 5 (a) IN GENERAL.—Section 9006 of the Patient Pro-
- 6 tection and Affordable Care Act, and the amendments

- 1 made thereby, are hereby repealed; and the Internal Rev-
- 2 enue Code of 1986 shall be applied as if such section, and
- 3 amendments, had never been enacted.
- 4 (b) Rescission of Unspent Federal Funds To
- 5 Offset Loss in Revenues.—

- (1) IN GENERAL.—Notwithstanding any other provision of law, of all available unobligated funds, \$44,000,000,000 in appropriated discretionary funds are hereby rescinded.
  - Office of Management and Budget shall determine and identify from which appropriation accounts the rescission under paragraph (1) shall apply and the amount of such rescission that shall apply to each such account. Not later than 60 days after the date of the enactment of this Act, the Director of the Office of Management and Budget shall submit a report to the Secretary of the Treasury and Congress of the accounts and amounts determined and identified for rescission under the preceding sentence.
    - (3) EXCEPTION.—This subsection shall not apply to the unobligated funds of the Department of Defense, the Department of Veterans Affairs, or the Social Security Administration.
