Mr. POE of Texas introduced the following bill; which was referred to the Committee on Foreign Affairs

A BILL

To terminate the designation of the Islamic Republic of Pakistan as a major non-NATO ally, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. TERMINATION OF DESIGNATION OF THE IS-**
4 **LAMIC REPUBLIC OF PAKISTAN AS A MAJOR**
5 **NON-NATO ALLY.**

6 Effective beginning on the date of the enactment of
7 this Act—

8 (1) the designation of the Islamic Republic of
9 Pakistan as a major non-NATO ally pursuant to
10 section 517(a)(1) of the Foreign Assistance Act of

1 1961 (22 U.S.C. 2321k(a)(1)) or any other provi-
2 sion of law is hereby terminated; and

3 (2) the President may not issue a separate des-
4 ignation of the Islamic Republic of Pakistan as a
5 major non-NATO ally pursuant to section 517(a)(1)
6 of such Act or any other provision of law.

7 **SEC. 2. REPORT ON COUNTRIES DESIGNATED AS A MAJOR**
8 **NON-NATO ALLIES.**

9 Not later than 1 year after the date of the enactment
10 of this Act, and annually thereafter, the President shall
11 submit to Congress a report that contains the following:

12 (1) A complete and updated list of each country
13 that is designated as a major non-NATO ally pursu-
14 ant to section 517(a)(1) of the Foreign Assistance
15 Act of 1961 (22 U.S.C. 2321k(a)(1)).

16 (2) A justification as to why each such country
17 should continue to be designated as a major non-
18 NATO ally pursuant to section 517(a)(1) of such
19 Act.

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
