Mr. GINGREY of Georgia introduced the following bill; which was referred to the Committee on the Budget

A BILL

To amend title 31, United States Code, to require the President to submit with the budget an estimate of the deficit using generally accepted accounting principles.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Generally Accepted
5 Accounting Principles Act” or the “GAAP Act”.

6 **SEC. 2. BUDGET DEFICIT CALCULATION USING GENERALLY**
7 **ACCEPTED ACCOUNTING PRINCIPLES.**

8 (a) IN GENERAL.—Section 1105(a) of title 31,
9 United States Code, is amended—

1 (1) by redesignating the second paragraph (37)
2 (relating to a list of plans and reports for elimi-
3 nation or consolidation) as paragraph (39); and

4 (2) by adding at the end the following new
5 paragraph:

6 “(40) an estimate of the deficit or surplus for
7 the fiscal year for which the budget is submitted,
8 prepared using generally accepted accounting prin-
9 ciples.”.

10 (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The requirement added by
11 subsection (a) shall take effect beginning with the budget
12 submission made by the President in 2014.

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
