A BILL

Making supplemental appropriations for fiscal year 2013 for recovery from damage caused by Hurricane Sandy, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Hurricane Sandy Re-
5 covery and Rebuilding Supplemental Appropriations Act,
6 2013”.

1 **SEC. 2. SUPPLEMENTAL APPROPRIATIONS FOR HURRI-**
 2 **CANE RECOVERY.**

3 The following sums are appropriated, out of any
 4 money in the Treasury not otherwise appropriated, for fis-
 5 cal year 2013:

6 DEPARTMENT OF DEFENSE—CIVIL

7 DEPARTMENT OF THE ARMY

8 CORPS OF ENGINEERS—CIVIL

9 FLOOD CONTROL AND COASTAL EMERGENCIES

10 For an additional amount for “Flood Control and
 11 Coastal Emergencies”, as authorized by section 5 of the
 12 Act of August 18, 1941 (33 U.S.C. 701n), for recovery
 13 from damage caused by Hurricane Sandy, \$45,000,000,
 14 to remain available until expended: *Provided*, That such
 15 amount is designated by the Congress as being for disaster
 16 relief pursuant to section 251(b)(2)(D) of the Balanced
 17 Budget and Emergency Deficit Control Act of 1985.

18 INDEPENDENT AGENCIES

19 SMALL BUSINESS ADMINISTRATION

20 DISASTER LOANS PROGRAM ACCOUNT

21 For an additional amount for “Disaster Loans Pro-
 22 gram Account” for the cost of direct loans authorized by
 23 section 7(b) of the Small Business Act, \$255,000,000, to
 24 remain available until expended: *Provided*, That such
 25 costs, including the cost of modifying such loans, shall be
 26 as defined in section 502 of the Congressional Budget Act

1 of 1974: *Provided further*, That such amount is designated
 2 by the Congress as being for disaster relief pursuant to
 3 section 251(b)(2)(D) of the Balanced Budget and Emer-
 4 gency Deficit Control Act of 1985.

5 DEPARTMENT OF HOMELAND SECURITY

6 FEDERAL EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT AGENCY

7 DISASTER RELIEF FUND

8 For an additional amount for the “Disaster Relief
 9 Fund” for recovery from damage caused by Hurricane
 10 Sandy, \$6,700,000,000, to remain available until ex-
 11 pended: *Provided*, That such amount is designated by the
 12 Congress as being for disaster relief pursuant to section
 13 251(b)(2)(D) of the Balanced Budget and Emergency
 14 Deficit Control Act of 1985.

15 DISASTER ASSISTANCE DIRECT LOAN PROGRAM ACCOUNT

16 For an additional amount for the “Disaster Assist-
 17 ance Direct Loan Program Account” for the cost of direct
 18 loans as authorized under section 417 of the Robert T.
 19 Stafford Disaster Relief and Emergency Assistance Act
 20 (42 U.S.C. 5184), to assist State and local governments
 21 affected by Hurricane Sandy, \$5,000,000,000: *Provided*,
 22 That section 417 of such Act shall be applied by sub-
 23 stituting “State or local government” for “local govern-
 24 ment” each place it appears: *Provided further*, That not-
 25 withstanding section 417(b) of such Act, the amount of

1 any such loan may exceed \$5,000,000, and may be equal
2 to not more than 50 percent of the annual operating budg-
3 et of the State or local government in any case in which
4 that State or local government has suffered a loss of 25
5 percent or more in tax revenues due to Hurricane Sandy:
6 *Provided further*, That the cost of modifying such loans
7 shall be as defined in section 502 of the Congressional
8 Budget Act of 1974 (2 U.S.C. 661a): *Provided further*,
9 That such amount is designated by the Congress as being
10 for disaster relief pursuant to section 251(b)(2)(D) of the
11 Balanced Budget and Emergency Deficit Control Act of
12 1985.

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
