## AN ACT

To prevent the 2013 pay adjustment for Members of Congress and persons holding other offices or positions in the Federal Government from being made.

1       *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2       *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

1 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

2 This Act may be cited as the “Congressional Pay  
3 Freeze and Fiscal Responsibility Act”.

4 **SEC. 2. ELIMINATION OF 2013 PAY ADJUSTMENT.**

5 (a) IN GENERAL.—Section 147 of the Continuing  
6 Appropriations Act, 2011, as amended by section 114(a)  
7 of the Continuing Appropriations Resolution, 2013 (Public  
8 Law 112–175; 5 U.S.C. 5303 note), is amended—

9 (1) in subsection (b)(1), by striking the matter  
10 after “ending on” and before “shall be made” and  
11 inserting “December 31, 2013,”; and

12 (2) in subsection (c), by striking the matter  
13 after “ending on” and before “no senior executive”  
14 and inserting “December 31, 2013,”.

15 (b) ELIMINATION OF DELAYED ADJUSTMENT.—Sec-  
16 tion 114(b) of the Continuing Appropriations Resolution,  
17 2013 is repealed.
