To authorize the Secretary of Agriculture to designate certain parts of California's San Joaquin Valley as a rural area for purposes of programs under the Consolidated Farm and Rural Development Act.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "San Joaquin Valley
- 5 USDA Rural Definition Inclusion Act".

1	SEC. 2. AUTHORITY OF THE SECRETARY OF AGRICULTURE
2	TO DESIGNATE CERTAIN PARTS OF CALIFOR-
3	NIA'S SAN JOAQUIN VALLEY AS A RURAL
4	AREA FOR PURPOSES OF PROGRAMS UNDER
5	THE CONSOLIDATED FARM AND RURAL DE-
6	VELOPMENT ACT.
7	Section 343(a)(13) of the Consilidated Farm and
8	Rural Development Act (7 U.S.C 1991(a)(13)) is amended
9	by adding at the end the following:
10	"(H) SAN JOAQUIN VALLEY.—Notwith-
11	standing any other provision of this paragraph,
12	within the areas of the California counties of
13	Fresno, Kern, Kings, Madera, Merced, San
14	Joaquin, Stanislaus, and Tulare, the Secretary
15	may designate any part of the areas as a rural
16	area if the Secretary determines that the part
17	is not urban in character, other than any area
18	included within the municipal boundaries of the
19	city of Bakersfield, Fresno, Modesto, Stockton,
20	or Visalia.''.
