7	(a) Expansion.—Section 1318(b) of title 38, United
8	States Code, is amended by striking "if—" and all that
9	follows through the period at the end and inserting the
10	following: "if the disability was continuously rated totally
11	disabling for a period of not less than one year imme-
12	diately preceding death.".
13	(b) Effective Date.—The amendment made by
14	subsection (a) shall apply with respect to deaths occurring
15	on or after the date of the enactment of this Act.
