3 SECTION 1. EXTENDING LENGTH OF FLIGHTS FROM RON4 ALD REAGAN WASHINGTON NATIONAL AIR5 PORT.

6 Section 41718 of title 49, United States Code, is7 amended by adding at the end the following:

"(g) Use of Airport Slots for Beyond Perim-1 ETER FLIGHTS.—Notwithstanding section 49109 or any 2 3 other provision of law, any air carrier that holds or oper-4 ates air carrier slots at Ronald Reagan Washington National Airport as of January 1, 2011, pursuant to subparts 5 6 K and S of part 93 of title 14, Code of Federal Regula-7 tions, which are being used as of that date for scheduled 8 service between that airport and a large hub airport may 9 use such slots for service between Ronald Reagan Washington National Airport and any airport located outside 10 of the perimeter restriction described in section 49109, ex-11 12 cept that an air carrier may not use multi-aisle or widebody aircraft to provide the service authorized by this 13 14 subsection.".
