1	SECTION 1. TREATMENT OF CLINICAL PSYCHOLOGISTS AS
2	PHYSICIANS FOR PURPOSES OF FURNISHING
3	CLINICAL PSYCHOLOGIST SERVICES.
4	(a) In General.—The first sentence of section
5	1861(r) of the Social Security Act (42 U.S.C. 1395x(r))
6	is amended—
7	(1) by striking "or" before "(5)"; and
8	(2) by inserting before the period the following:
9	", or (6) a clinical psychologist, but only with re-
10	spect to the furnishing of qualified psychologist serv-
11	ices described in subsection (ii) for which the psy-
12	chologist is legally authorized to perform by the
13	State and who is acting within the scope of the psy-
14	chologist's license (or other authorization under
15	State law)".
16	(b) Effective Date.—The amendments made by
17	subsection (a) shall apply to items and services furnished
18	on or after January 1, 2012.
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
