2 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

3 This resolution may be cited as the "Holding Con-4 gress Accountable Act of 2011".

5 SEC. 2. ONLINE POSTING OF DISBURSEMENTS FROM MEM-

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BERS' REPRESENTATIONAL ALLOWANCE.

7 (a) REQUIRING POSTING.—

1 (1) IN GENERAL.—With respect to each session 2 of a Congress—

(A) the Chief Administrative Officer of the 3 4 House of Representatives shall post on the offi-5 cial public Internet site of the House of Rep-6 resentatives a statement showing each disburse-7 ment made from the Members' Representa-8 tional Allowance during that session, and in-9 clude as part of the statement hyperlinks to in-10 formation on the amount of such disbursements 11 which are attributable to each specific Member 12 of the House of Representatives; and

(B) except as provided in paragraph (2),
each Member of the House of Representatives
shall include on the Member's official public
Internet site a hyperlink to the information provided on the House of Representatives site
under subparagraph (A) with respect to the disbursements made by the Member.

20 (2) EXCEPTION FOR FORMER MEMBERS.—
21 Paragraph (1)(B) does not apply to any individual
22 who is not a Member of the House of Representa23 tives at the time the Chief Administrative Officer
24 posts the statement described in paragraph (1)(A).

1 (b) SOURCE OF INFORMATION.—The information 2 provided on the House of Representatives site under sub-3 section (a)(1) shall be based on the reports of disburse-4 ments for the operations of the House of Representatives 5 which are submitted by the Chief Administrative Officer 6 under section 106 of the House of Representatives Admin-7 istrative Reform Technical Corrections Act (2 U.S.C. 8 104b).

9 (c) DEADLINES.—

10 (1) CHIEF ADMINISTRATIVE OFFICER.—The 11 Chief Administrative Officer shall post the informa-12 tion required under subsection (a)(1) with respect to 13 a session of Congress not later than 30 days after 14 the publication of the final report of disbursements 15 for the operations of the House of Representatives 16 (as described in subsection (b)) for that session.

17 (2) MEMBERS.—Each Member of the House of
18 Representatives shall meet the requirements of sub19 section (a)(2) not later than 5 days after the Chief
20 Administrative Officer posts the information re21 quired under subsection (a)(1) with respect to a ses22 sion of Congress.

(d) MEMBER DEFINED.—In this section, a "Member
 of the House of Representatives" includes a Delegate or
 Resident Commissioner to the Congress.

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
