RESOLUTION

- Expressing support for designation of March 2011 as "National Kidney Cancer and Kidney Health Awareness Month".
- Whereas an estimated 58,240 people in the United States were expected to be diagnosed with kidney cancer in 2010;
- Whereas an estimated 13,000 people in the United States were expected to die from kidney cancer in 2010;
- Whereas kidney cancer is the eighth most common cancer in the United States and kidney disease is the ninth leading cause of death in the United States;
- Whereas there are 400,000 people being kept alive through dialysis or kidney transplants;

- Whereas ongoing research promises further improvements in kidney cancer and kidney disease prevention, early detection, and treatments;
- Whereas educating people in the United States about early detection strategies for kidney cancer and kidney disease is critical to saving lives; and
- Whereas March 2011 would be an appropriate month to designate as "National Kidney Cancer and Kidney Health Awareness Month": Now, therefore, be it
 - 1 *Resolved*, That the House of Representatives—
- 2 (1) supports the designation of "National Kid-3 ney Cancer and Kidney Health Awareness Month"; 4 (2) salutes kidney cancer and kidney disease 5 survivors in the United States and the efforts of pa-6 tients, survivors, volunteers, and professionals who 7 combat kidney cancer and kidney disease each day; 8 (3) recognizes national and community organizations for their work in promoting awareness of 9 10 kidney health screening and offering treatment to 11 kidney cancer and kidney disease sufferers; 12 (4) acknowledges the necessity of discovering

both the causes and cures for kidney cancer and kid-ney disease; and

(5) urges organizations and health practitioners
to use this opportunity to promote kidney health
awareness and encourage annual health physicals.
