RESOLUTION

Amending the Rules of the House of Representatives to provide that the House may not consider any reported bill until at least 72 hours after it is reported.

1 *Resolved*, That clause 11 of rule XXI of the Rules
2 of the House of Representatives is amended to read as
3 follows:

4 “11. It shall not be in order to consider a bill or joint
5 resolution that has not been reported by a committee until
6 such measure has been available to Members, Delegates,
7 and the Resident Commissioner for 72 hours (excluding
8 Saturdays, Sundays, or legal holidays except when the
9 House is in session on such a day) in which such measure

1 has been available to Members, Delegates, and the Resi-
2 dent Commissioner.”.
