RESOLUTION

Expressing support for designation of October 2011 as National Chiropractic Health Month.

- Whereas the use of technology such as personal computers, smart phones, and other hand-held devices has rapidly increased over the past 20 years;
- Whereas such equipment can involve hours of sitting in the same place, holding the body in strained positions, or using repetitive motions that lead to inflammation and pain;
- Whereas inactivity and poor posture can cause back pain and neck strain, which can lead to neck pain and headaches and pain in other parts of the body;

- Whereas back pain is one of the most common reasons for visits to a physician and accounts for about \$50,000,000,000 in health care costs per year;
- Whereas repetitive stress injuries from texting and computer use are increasing and cause about 28 percent of the workforce to miss days on the job;
- Whereas musculoskeletal injuries in general are one of the biggest workplace health and safety problems in United States industry today;
- Whereas Doctors of Chiropractic (DCs) are health care providers who focus on the whole person and have particular expertise in the prevention and care of musculoskeletal injuries;
- Whereas DCs are also experts in ergonomics and can teach those who use technology frequently how to prevent injuries such as back pain, neck pain, and repetitive strains;
- Whereas National Chiropractic Health Month serves as a reminder to all United States citizens of the importance of being "TechnoHealthy" by using technology safely and making time to rest, exercise, and engage in other wellness-enhancing activities; and
- Whereas October 2011 would be an appropriate month to designate as National Chiropractic Health Month: Now, therefore, be it
