 6 immediately after that vote, a moment of silence shall be
 7 observed on behalf of those killed or wounded (as well as

their families) in the current United States engagement
 in Afghanistan.

3 "(b) The Speaker shall not delegate this responsi4 bility to any other Member unless the Speaker is not phys5 ically in the United States Capitol, a House office build6 ing, or a Senate office building.".
