A BILL

To authorize Department of Defense support for programs on pro bono legal assistance for members of the Armed Forces.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-

- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Justice for Troops
- 5 Act".
- 6 SEC. 2. DEPARTMENT OF DEFENSE SUPPORT FOR PRO-
- 7 GRAMS ON PRO BONO LEGAL ASSISTANCE
- 8 FOR MEMBERS OF THE ARMED FORCES.
- 9 (a) Support Authorized.—The Secretary of De-
- 10 fense may provide support to one or more public or private

- 1 programs designed to connect attorneys who provide pro
- 2 bono legal assistance with members of the Armed Forces
- 3 who are in need of such assistance.
- 4 (b) Financial Support.—
- 5 (1) IN GENERAL.—The support provided a pro-6 gram under subsection (a) may include financial 7 support of the program.
- 8 (2) LIMITATION ON AMOUNT.—The total 9 amount of financial support provided under sub-10 section (a) in any fiscal year may not exceed 11 \$500,000.
 - (3) Funding.—Amounts for financial support under this section shall be derived from amounts authorized to be appropriated for the Department of Defense for operation and maintenance.
