To exempt children of certain Filipino World War II veterans from the numerical limitations on immigrant visas and for other purposes.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Filipino Veterans
- 5 Family Reunification Act of 2011".
- 6 SEC. 2. EXEMPTION FROM IMMIGRANT VISA LIMIT.
- 7 Section 201(b)(1) of the Immigration and Nationality
- 8 Act (8 U.S.C. 1151(b)(1)) is amended by adding at the
- 9 end the following:

1	"(F) Aliens who—
2	"(i) are eligible for a visa under paragraph
3	(1) or (3) of section 203(a); and
4	"(ii) have a parent (regardless of whether
5	the parent in living or dead) who was natural-
6	ized pursuant to—
7	"(I) section 405 of the Immigration
8	Act of 1990 (Public Law 101–649; 8
9	U.S.C. 1440 note); or
10	"(II) title III of the Act of October
11	14, 1940 (54 Stat. 1137, chapter 876), as
12	added by section 1001 of the Second War
13	Powers Act, 1942 (56 Stat. 182, chapter
14	199).".
