certain public works on rivers and harbors, and for other purposes," approved March 4, 1915 (33 U.S.C. 560), is 3 amended in the matter before the proviso— 4 (1) by inserting "for work, which includes planning and design," after "to be expended"; and 5 6 (2) by striking "work of" and inserting "study 7 or project for". 8 SEC. 3. ADVANCED FUNDS FOR NAVIGATION STUDIES. 9 Section 11 of the Act entitled "An Act Authorizing 10 the construction, repair, and preservation of certain public works on rivers and harbors, and for other purposes," approved March 3, 1925 (33 U.S.C. 561), is amended in the first sentence— 13 14 (1) by striking "a work of" and inserting "work, which includes planning and design, for an 15 16 authorized study or project for a"; and 17 (2) by striking "duly adopted and authorized by 18 law". 19 SEC. 4. CONTRIBUTIONS BY STATES AND POLITICAL DIVI-20 SIONS. 21 Section 5 of the Act of June 22, 1936 (33 U.S.C. 22 701h), is amended— 23 (1) by inserting "for work, which includes planning and design," before "to be expended"; and 24
