To prohibit the further extension or establishment of national monuments in Utah except by express authorization of Congress.

1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the United States of America in Congress assembled, 2 3 SECTION 1. LIMITATION ON FURTHER EXTENSION OR ES-4 TABLISHMENT OF NATIONAL MONUMENTS IN 5 UTAH. 6 This proviso of the last sentence of the first section 7 of the Act of September 14, 1950 (64 Stat. 849, chapter 950; 16 U.S.C. 431a), is amended by inserting "or Utah" 8 after "Wyoming". 9
